

Dear Applicant:

This is your checklist for the NEXUS for Affordable Housing, Inc. scholarship process. **Please follow all instructions carefully.**

There are three ways to submit your application: You can download the fillable PDF version of this application at www.nexus.org/scholarship and submit it online, or type or handwrite the form and scan/email it to contact@nexusfah.org, or mail it to the address at the bottom of this page.

Remember that the items that must be completed by others (the reference letters and the form for high school seniors on page 5) must be mailed by the person who writes the recommendation or by the school. The application must reach the NEXUS office no later than **June 30, 2017**.

Please note that if you are a high school senior, Section B on page 5 must be completed and submitted to NEXUS by a school official.

- Certification of Residence Form**

- High School and/or College transcripts**
Please request your transcripts well in advance. They do not need to be sealed, official transcripts. If you have taken a break from attending school, please explain why on a separate sheet of paper. Any applications without transcripts will not be accepted.
 - **High school seniors and high school graduates:** *Please send high school transcripts.*
 - **Current college or trade school students:** *If your transcript shows at least two quarters or semesters of grades, you are only required to send college/trade school transcripts. If your current transcript shows only 1 quarter/semester of grades, you are required to send high school transcripts in addition to your current transcript.*

- Two (2) recommendations**
*Recommendation forms must be sent separately from your application, **directly from the person making the recommendation**. These recommendations can be found in this application and may be completed by teachers, employers, youth group leaders, etc.*

*Please provide a copy of the form to those who will be giving the recommendation, and before the deadline, be sure to follow up to confirm that they have mailed the form in. Completed recommendations must be in the NEXUS office no later than **June 30, 2017**. Applications without both recommendations will not be submitted to the judges.*

Q. On what criteria are the scholarship awards based?

A. Judging is based on grades, SAT scores, your essay and need.

Q. I will be attending a community college or an online or vocational/trade school. Can I still apply?

A. Yes, applicants who will be enrolling in 4-year or community colleges or vocational schools are eligible.

Q. I forgot to include a document with my scholarship application. May I send it in after the deadline?

A. No, the deadline for receiving applications in the NEXUS office is **June 30, 2017**. This is a firm deadline with no extensions. Please double check your packet against the provided checklist before sending it in. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Q. Who judges the scholarship applications, and when will judging take place?

A. The NEXUS for Affordable Housing, Inc. Board of Directors
Judging will take place in October, and all applicants will be notified by July 17, 2017.

Q. What is the dollar amount of the scholarship awards?

A. Individual scholarships are awarded based on merit and need, and there is no predetermined number of winners or individual scholarship amount that will be awarded.

Q. If I win a scholarship, how and when will I receive the award check?

A. Scholarships must be used within one calendar year and will be

disbursed after proof of college enrollment for Fall 2017 has been provided. In most cases, checks will be made payable to the educational institution. However, other arrangements may be reviewed by the committee as necessary.

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ELIGIBILITY: NEXUS scholarships are awarded to current residents of registered affordable housing managed by NEXUS members. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age and must be in college OR high school seniors OR high school graduates OR hold a high school equivalency certificate. Applicants must have applied to and be potentially eligible for admission for Fall 2017 to the college indicated on the scholarship application. If you are selected as a scholarship winner, you will be required to send proof of college enrollment for Fall 2017.
